The UNIDEE Residency Programs of Cittadellarte-Fondazione Pistoletto celebrate 25 years of artistic residencies dedicated to art and social transformation. Founded in 1999 by Michelangelo Pistoletto, the residency programs have seen the participation of thousand of artists and cultural professionals from more than fifty different countries, demonstrating what art historian Gregory Sholette considers "a far-sighted and vibrant investment in the future of innovative, intellectually stimulating, and socially engaged cultural practices." To celebrate this milestone, the 26th edition of Arte al Centro exhibition focuses on the 25 years of UNIDEE Residency Programs, reflecting on the past, present, and future of artistic residencies for social transformation. From September 21 to 25, performances, workshops, and family activities are organised with UNIDEE Alumni. The activities extend throughout Biella with "UNIDEE in città," involving galleries, cultural associations, commercial activities, and cinemas.

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PROGRAMME

The programme aims to reflect on the transformation of socially engaged artistic practices over the past twenty-five years, attempting to outline the many possibilities of becoming an art that inherently crosses into other disciplines. The themes addressed reflect emerging and urgent issues of contemporary society: from the ecological turn and the call to rethink the needs and specificities of places in relation to those who inhabit them; to new configurations for future artistic institutions, how they can be imagined and implemented; the pedagogical dimension as an essential condition of socially engaged art; and hospitality as a method within the context of artistic residencies as germinal places for acquiring new capacities.

Friday, 20th September

18.00 — 19.30 | Drop-in activities and workshops from UNIDEE Alumni

Activities will take place at the UNIDEE project space and refreshments will be offered.

- The Mais uno+1 collective will share a selection of short films from past projects, followed by a discussion about the collective and its practices. A short "Lisbon Drawing Club" exercise will be offered. Since its creation in 2021, the Mais uno+1 collective (Nicole Sánchez + Ligia Fernandes), an open, multidisciplinary and horizontal collective, has been developing projects that bring together artists + communities + territories in Lisbon and its suburbs.

Walking Conversation with Luigi Coppola and Owen Griffiths

In times of accelerated global and local challenges, where global and local challenges are increasingly pressing, and the pace of life is constantly accelerating, we respond to the need to share the skills and methodologies of socially engaged artistic practices. To do this, we aim to create spaces for dialogue on ecological, political, and economic issues, seeking ways of cohabiting with the planet that do not involve its exploitation and go beyond anthropocentric dominance. Owen Griffiths and Luigi Coppola will lead a silent walk through various collective actions at different points along the route. At the end of the collective exploration, the artists will organize a moment of reflection, where participants will be invited to create a choral sound intervention, also incorporating the sounds of the surrounding nature.

^{*} **Spazio HYDRO** is a cultural centre that promotes visual and performing arts, social research, and civic cohesion. Active since 2016, it is managed by the Better Places APS association - a volunteer-run organisation that promotes experimentation and collaboration in Biella. Their program of activities includes music events, club nights, performances and exhibitions as well as educational projects and a web-based community radio station.

UNIDEE in città

The programme includes a series of interventions spread throughout Biella in collaboration with local organisations and associations to highlight how the artistic residency programme has woven relationships over the past 25 years with public space, people and the city's transformation processes.

The shop windows of Via Italia (Biella)

Rewinding the series of memories, the artists who over time have experienced the city through the UNIDEE residency programmes have summarised in a limited series of eight short posters moments and experiences lived among the people, nature and different realities of Biella. These interventions extend the exhibition beyond the physical spaces of Cittadellarte, to highlight how the artistic residency programme has interwoven relations with public space, people and the processes of transformation of the city over these 25 years.
